

## 6 Media Accreditation

The accreditation badge is your key to access at the 2025 UCI Paracycling Road World Championships and is also the tool that keeps venues safe and secure, allowing them to operate smoothly and efficiently.


You must always wear your badge, and keep it visible, when accessing and moving around accredited venues.

Please be aware that the accreditation badge does not act as a visa to enter Belgium.

## 6.1 Accessing venues

Accredited media do not automatically have access to all venues of field of play. Please read the venue media operations.



#### **6.2 Accreditation Centre**

You can collect your accreditation badge at the Accreditation Centre – De Ververij.

- Saturday 30 August: 8:45 am 7:00 pm
- Sunday 31 August: 8:45 am 5:00 pm

Please note you must collect your badge in person, you cannot collect on behalf of another individual.

You will also need to show the approval email, and you may be asked to show one or more of the following: original identity document (i.e. passport or driving license), your professional card and/or the assignment letter you submitted with your accreditation request.

# 7 Transport

## 7.1 Parking

Parking spaces will be provided for everyone with press accreditation.

One week before the event, you will receive your parking ticket(s) by email, together with your PPO (point de passage obligatoire - more information below).

## **7.2** By Car

On your parking ticket, you will receive a QR code with a PPO (point de passage obligatoire) where you need to drive to. From there, follow the signs and turn off your GPS. You need to follow the event signalisation for 'PRESS'.

The press parking is close to the accreditation centre and to the media venue.

# 8 Media Venue Operations

#### 8.1 Media centre

Ronse will have a dedicated media centre that the accredited media can access. Located at Visit Ronse. Please note that only media in possession of an accreditation badge with access to the venue and the media centre can enter.

The venue media centre will provide the following facilities and services:

- Welcome desk managed by venue media centre staff to assist with all enquiries
- Press and photographers' workstations available
- Power and internet connectivity
- TV screen showing the competition
- Printed start lists
- Printing service (via the welcome desk)
- Refreshment station offering free tea, coffee, water,
- Lunch from Wednesday to Sunday (sandwiches)

- Friday 29 August: 8:30 am to 9:00 pm
- Saturday 30 August: 8:30 am to 9:00 pm
- Sunday 31 August: 8:30 am to 10:00 pm

## 8.2 Photographer information

#### 8.2.1 Photographer bibs

Photographers must wear their press accreditation badge plus their photographer bib at all times when working in an official venue or on the field of play at the UCI Para-cycling Road World Championships. Photographer bibs will be distributed in the venue media centre immediately after the mandatory photographers' briefing.

The bibs are numbered, assigned to each individual and are valid for the duration of the competition. You cannot swap bibs with another photographer and bibs cannot be replaced in the event of loss. No cash deposit is necessary to receive your bib however all bibs should be returned to the media centre after the competition has finished so they can be recycled.

The UCI determines the type of bib assigned to each photographer for each venue. There are two types of bibs which do/don't give access to the field of play:

Bib colour & category	Access
Red – FOP Photographer  PHOTO	<ul> <li>Red zone platform to finish line</li> <li>Podium</li> <li>FOP sidelines</li> <li>Red bibs get priority to yellow bibs when necessary</li> </ul>

Yellow - Non-FOP Photographer



- Yellow zone platform to finish line
- Podium
- FOP sidelines
- Red bibs get priority to yellow bibs when necessary

#### 8.2.2 Photographer briefing

Mandatory photographers' briefing will take place on **Thursday 28th of August at 10:30 am in the media venue**. Photographer bibs will be distributed immediately after this briefing from 11:00 am.

## 8.3 Filming Rights

The right to film such content is solely restricted to accredited audiovisual media and requires permission of the UCI.

Media accredited as written press (reporters or photographers) are not permitted to film any content from races, interviews, mixed zone activity or award ceremonies.

Enquiries regarding filming in Ronse should be directed to <a href="mailto:press@ronse2025.com">press@ronse2025.com</a>. The LOC is in contact with UCI for the allocation.

Audiovisual media are provided with a bib and must wear this (along with the accreditation badge) while working in an official UCI Paracycling Road World Championships venue or on the Field of Play. The bibs have different colours for each category, are numbered and cannot



be swapped with anyone else. The bibs provide access to different areas within the Championships, corresponding to the agreed rights.



Maximum 2 accredited personnel: 1 cameraperson, 1 journalist.

Photographers/Tea m Videographers



• Team areas

FOP (filming only on request)

Can film training sessions and behind-the-scenes.

Can publish maximum 3 minutes of race footage per day, with 24-hour embargo.

Cannot compile race footage from multiple days into one clip unless specifically approved (additional costs may apply).

Cannot film in front of official UCI or organiser sponsor banners.

Can access news content (free).

Can access live recordings (subject to technical fees).

Maximum 1 team videographer per NF, 1 camera per videographer.



The distribution of bibs are managed by the UCI and will take place in the Media Venue on Thursday 28th of August from 10:30 a.m.

#### 8.4 Mixed zone

The mixed zone is the designated area for post-competition athlete interviews. Medalists (1st, 2nd and 3rd place) will be accompanied to the mixed zone for media availability.

Interviews with other athletes can be arranged on request by contacting the team's press attaché or the mixed zone manager.

#### 8.5 Press conferences

A press conference will be held on 26 August at 10:30 a.m. in **De Passage**, Ronse.

#### 8.6 Motorbike reservations

Motorbikes are available for use during the event. Reservations must be made **no later than 12:00 noon the day before** the requested day of use.

Confirmation will be provided on that same day after the final podium ceremony.
